

Monthly Postgraduate Classical Homeopathic Course

Program descriptions:

A live course designed to meet the challenge of daily homeopathic practice and help professional homeopaths to grow in their understanding and application of classical homeopathy (for more details see next page)

Each class is approved for four CPD hours in category 1. *The format for each class remains the same: Remedy discussion, Case presentation/discussion, and Practice guidance/Basic homeopathic science research. Each class includes time for discussion and each participant has a chance to ask questions related to their own practice. Cases are selected before the next class and presented as anonymous paper cases or live cases. The brochure is updated according to the cases presented.*

A sign-in attendance sheet will be provided at each meeting and allocated CPD hours recorded. To obtain CPD credit you must attend the entire class and complete the post-training evaluation survey after each class.

Background requirement:

The program is designed for 8-10 graduate students with a minimum of four years of classical homeopathic training and some clinical experience (as part of the school program or currently practicing).
